

Outdoor Classroom Case Study

Claremont School

Brief...

The Parent Teacher Association for Claremont School put out a tender for the construction of a reading hut. The hut would need to encompass seating, provide shelter, and be robust enough to withstand the use of many enthusiastic children in an outdoor environment.

Solution...

The Lapa Company designed a reading hut with integrated bench seating enabling a number of pupils to engage with the space at once. The half height timber side panels were added for greater shelter versus a traditional open balustrade and Cedar Shingle Roof Tiles were selected for their durability. As the school had no suitable base available, we constructed a small wooden platform to hold the hut.

Following a successful tender bid, Claremont School commissioned The Lapa Company to design and construct a reading hut for the school grounds. Craig Ormiston immediately understood the design brief and he was helpful and informative throughout.
